CULTURE OF BERRI ROUGE (Oreochromis sp.)

- 1) The aim of the berri rouge culture is to provide fingerlings to fish farmers upon request.
- 2) Fingerlings are available at the Albion Fisheries Research Centre (AFRC) from September to April.
- 3) The cost of berri rouge fingerlings is Rs. 1.25 / unit.
- 4) Technical advice on culture techniques are dispensed to fish farmers upon request.
- 5) Farmers should apply for a water right for aquaculture from the Water Resources Unit / Central Water Authority of the Ministry of Energy and Public Utilities. **Tap water is not recommended for aquaculture.**
- 6) Request for supply of fingerlings should be made on the **Application Form for Fish Farming.**
- 7) Farmers should submit fish production data to the Ministry on a yearly basis.
