Electronic bidding shall not be permitted. Late bids will be rejected.

A pre-bid meeting/and a site visit is scheduled on **Tuesday 14th August 2018 at 10.00hrs at Case-Noyale Fisheries Post.** Bids will be opened in the presence of bidders or their representatives who choose to attend in person at the Conference Room, Level 4, LIC Centre, President John Kennedy St, Port-Louis on **Wednesday 29th August 2018 at 14.00 hrs.**

The Ministry reserves the right to annul the bidding process and reject all bids at any time prior to award of contract as per provision of section 39(1) of the Public Procurement Act 2006.
